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To whom it may concern,

My name is Satty Giil Keswani MD. I am a 72 year old Gynecologist and have been in practice for over 35 years in Livingston NJ

I am writing not only as a Physician but mostly as a former patient of DR. Corsello. I want to join my voice to that of the many patients and other physicians who like to see this wonderful lady restored to the position that she so clearly deserves. I have read the charges and the response that Dr Corsello provided. I am satisfied with her reply which makes much more sense than the accusations and gives ample evidence of the OPMC malice.

I find it most distressing to see that the health department leveled unfounded and spurious accusations against her and used her Attorney's error to avoid a proper review of their charges. This in itself makes me suspicious of their motives.

As a physician I find highly irregular to see that, among the charges, a prominent one was that of **over testing**. In other to justify their accusations they resorted to braking down panels such as the CBC and Differential and the Comprehensive metabolic panel in distinct singular tests. This is totally unacceptable. We physicians use these tests as preliminary general screening in all our patients. I assume that, by breaking down these commonly used panels in their components, they wished to give an impression of lots of different tests. This in itself shows intent to obscurer the true nature of their purpose. In my long career I have never witnessed such improper behavior.

I first met DR Corsello in January 1994 when I had been diagnosed with bronco spasm of unknown origin which didn't respond to steroids and other conventional treatments. I was referred to her by a satisfied patient of mine and traveled all the way from NJ to LI to consult with her and get some of the treatments she prescribed. I was most impressed with her lengthy and through evaluation process that took over two hours.

I first thought this was a treatment reserved to Colleagues I subsequently learned that this was standard procedure in her office. Every thing about her office was exceptional and should be in fact the standard by which medicine ought to be practiced.

Her staff was most caring, professional, courteous and efficient. I met her Physician Assistants, her nurses, the stress management intake psychotherapist, her administrative staff and they were all extremely professional and qualified. I can't imagine who the health Department considered unqualified.

Like all other patients, after her consultation I sat with one of her nurses who sat on the initial consultation and was given the opportunity to go over again the entire program again. I realized that this was a way of reinforcing the need to follow the life style modifications that were part of the overall program. I was given lots of information, material pertaining to my treatment and ample time to question every step of the process. I was informed about possible side effects and outcome. Most importantly it was clear to me and other patients that this office operated on a totally patient centered fashion which, as you can imagine, came from the top down.

I was most impressed with Dr Corsello diagnostic skills as she traveled with me diligently, step by step through the meanders of the possible causes of my new condition. Together we learned that the precipitating cause of my untreatable bronchial spasm was my recent exposure to DDT during a convention in Nairobi Kenya, both on the plane and in the hotel. This exposure, incidentally forbidden in USA, had overwhelmed my liver detoxification processes and caused symptoms in an area in which I was genetically weak.

What my conventional colleagues couldn't do in two months of heavy medication she accomplished with a few infusions of antioxidants and liver detoxification substances. I have never ceased to admire Dr Corsello high skills, her kindness her maturity and the fact she has endured a most vicious persecution with dignity and great courage. History is full of persecuted leaders of new ideas but this doesn't justify such a behavior in a Society that aspires to JUSTICE for all.

Give Dr Corsello any consideration for the recovery of her medical license so she can continue to treat the many people who have lost the ability to access her voluminous knowledge for the past 3 years.
